Approval conditions:

- 1. This approval is for the proposed construction of a potato cooler on plot No. Mosop/Nyaru/258, Keiyo South Sub County, Elgeyo Marakwet County.
- 2. Ensure that the proposed activity is approved by the County Government of Elgeyo Marakwet prior to commencement of works.
- 3. Comply with the relevant principal laws, by-laws and guidelines issued for development of such a project within the jurisdiction of the Elgeyo Marakwet County Government; Ministry of Lands, Housing and Urban Development; Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure; Ministry of Health, National Construction Authority; Directorate of Occupational Health and Safety Services and other relevant Authorities.
- 4. Ensure that the proposed development will not encroach on way-leaves and road reserves.
- 5. Ensure that the excavated areas are backfilled and restored to a state equivalent to the original state or improved.
- 6. Ensure that all excavated material and debris is collected, re-used and where need be; disposed off as per the Environmental Management and Coordination (Waste Management) Regulations, 2006.
- 7. Ensure strict adherence to the provisions of Environmental Management and Coordination (Air Quality) Regulations, 2014.
- 8. Ensure strict adherence to the provisions of Environmental Management and Coordination (Noise and Excessive Vibration Pollution Control) Regulations, 2009.
- 9. In the event that the project site borders a wetland, the proponent, pursuant to regulation 6(c) of the Water Quality Regulations, 2006, shall protect the riparian by ensuring that NO development activity is undertaken within the full width of the stream to a maximum of six (6) metres on either side based on the highest recorded flood levels.
- 10. Put in place an appropriate traffic management plan that will ensure smooth traffic flow on the narrow estate roads.
